

GRACE COMMUNITY CHURCH NURSERY

At Grace Community Church our desire is to create a safe, fun, and grace-filled environment for your children to grow in their relationship with God and others. In order to do so, we ask that you abide by the following regulations:

The nursery available for children ages 6 months through 2nd grade

1. All children in the nursery must have a "Child Information Sheet" on file and should be updated every September
2. All children must be dropped off and picked up by a parent/guardian. NO child will be released from the nursery unless to a parent/guardian.
3. Upon arrival to the nursery, each child must be checked-in by a nursery volunteer. Each family will sign-in child in the nursery sign-in binder. If a parent is needed in the nursery, a text will be sent to the parent.
4. The nursery opens at 10:30am and will remain open until 5 minutes after the end of the service in a timely manner.
5. If a child has been sick, we ask that he/she be fever/symptom free for 24 hours before coming to the nursery.
6. Only the day's assigned CORI approved nursery volunteers are permitted in the nursery while it is in operation. All other volunteers must be up-stairs attending the service.

Notes:

- Babies and children are always welcomed in the sanctuary.
- If necessary, parents with babies may watch live feed of the service in the Parent's Room, located adjacent to the sanctuary.
- Parents with children **3rd grade and up** are asked to supervise their (own) children in the sanctuary during the service. Children's activity sheets and supplies are provided at the rear of the sanctuary. Please return unused supplies at the end of the service.
