MARBLEHEAD HISTORY

- 1629 First English Settlers in Marblehead
- 1633 The first mention of the name "Marblehead" in the Colonial records "July 2, 1633, James White is fined for drunkeness by him committed at Marblehead.."
- 1636 The first Colonial slave ship is constructed in Marblehead, "The Desire."
- 1684 The First Church of Christ (Congregational) was formally organized.

MARBLEHEAD HISTORY

- 1714 St. Michael's Episcopal Church built
- 1810 21 people gathered as First Baptist Church at "Rock Meeting House"
- 1833 Built Pleasant Street building
- Late 1830s 2nd Great Awakening; 236 members;
 71 baptisms in one year
- 1867 Building burned to ground and rebuilt next year

MARBLEHEAD HISTORY

- 1950 Purchased Parsonage on Elm St
- 1958 Education wing built
- 2003 FBC votes to leave ABC-USA and makes substantial changes to By-Laws
- 2004 Named changed to "Grace Community Church"
- 2010 Nursery remodeled
- 2022 Steeple rebuilt

THEOLOGY

- GCC is not formally affiliated with any denomination or theological organization.
- Our aim is to be a historic Christian church that by faithfully following God's word, seeks to wholeheartedly worship and honor Jesus Christ, live the Gospel before all, and minister the Gospel to our community. In practice we seek to focus most of our attention on the major doctrines of our faith and the essential elements of a faithful walk with Christ.

THEOLOGY

"In Essentials Unity, In Non-Essentials Liberty, In All Things Charity"

THE BIBLE

We believe that the entire Bible, consisting of the sixty-six accepted books of the Old and New Testaments, is verbally inspired by God, and is therefore inerrant in the original writings and of supreme and final authority in all matters of faith and life.

GOD

We believe that there is only one living and true God, Creator of all things, infinitely perfect and eternally existing in three Persons: Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

JESUS

We believe that Jesus Christ is true God and true man; who became flesh, being conceived by the Holy Spirit and born of the Virgin Mary, lived a sinless life, died on the cross as the sinner's substitute, rose bodily from the dead, and ascended to the right hand of God where He intercedes on our behalf.

THE HOLY SPIRIT

We believe that the work of the Holy Spirit is to glorify God through Jesus Christ by convicting men of sin, righteousness and judgment, and by regenerating, indwelling, instructing, guiding, comforting and empowering believers for godly living and service.

SIN

We believe that man was created in the image of God but fell from his sinless state through disobedience and thus brought all mankind into a state of sin and spiritual death, which is eternal separation from God. Because of this sinful state all are alienated from God by nature and by choice.

SALVATION

We believe that salvation is a gift of God's grace alone, manifested by repentance toward God and faith in Jesus Christ who died on the cross for our sins as a representative and substitutionary sacrifice for all who believe.

THE CHURCH

We believe that all Christians, those yielded to the Lordship of Jesus Christ, baptized by the Holy Spirit and justified before God, are united together in the Body of Christ, the Church, of which He is the sovereign Head.

THE CHURCH

We believe that the universal Church of Christ is composed of the redeemed of all ages and is visibly manifested in local companies of believers who come together for worship, witness, mutual edification and service.

THE CHURCH

We believe that the Church is to observe the ordinances of Baptism and the Lord's Supper as instituted by the Lord Jesus Christ, not as a means of salvation but as visible symbols of the realities of salvation.

THE END

We believe that Jesus Christ will personally and visibly come again at the close of the age, bringing His rewards for those who believe in Him and eternal punishment for those who reject Him.

"For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received: that Christ died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures..." (1 Corinthians 15:3-4)
